Dr. Kate Tulenko is a physician and health systems and health workforce expert. In 2020 she founded the Center for Health Professional School and launched the 500 Health Professional Schools Initiative to train and additional 1 million new health workers.

She is also the founder and CEO of Corvus Health, a global health workforce firm with the goal of giving all people access to skilled health workers. Previously, she was the director of the US government's global health workforce project and the former coordinator of the World Bank's Africa Health Workforce program. She was named one of "50 Women in Global Health Security" by Women in Global Health and one of "300 Women Leaders in Global Health" by the Geneva Graduate Institute. She received her bachelors in biochemistry from Harvard, her masters in history and philosophy of science at Emmanuel College, Cambridge, her MD from the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine, and her masters of public health from the Johns Hopkins School of Public Health where she serves as an adjunct professor.
