

Professor Laetitia Rispel (PhD)

Professor of Public Health, National Research Foundation-rated researcher, and a chair holder of the South African Research Chairs Initiative (SARChI) at the University of the Witwatersrand (Wits) in Johannesburg, South Africa. Her research focuses on human resources for health and its intersection with the performance of the health system and other social determinants of health.

She has published extensively, and has won several national and international awards. She is a former president of the World Federation of Public Health Associations (2018-2020), the first woman from Africa to achieve this honour.
